

Advent Candles are usually comprised of three purple candles with one rose or pink. The candles recall the weeks that pass until Christmas. Purple candles symbolize waiting, also penitential but not in the same way as Lent. Rose or Pink is used on the third Sunday of Advent to symbolize rejoicing, since the Third Sunday of Advent is referred to as Gaudete (Rejoice) Sunday. They are lit, light used as a symbol of Christ being the light of the World coming through the darkness. Sometimes a white candle is placed in the middle, people use when lit as the representation of Christ entering the world.


